## France

### Bordeaux

- 6 *Domaine de Ricaud* *Chaigne & Fils* 2011/12 2 **17.00**

*A blend of Sauvignon & Semillon which combines fresh, intense aromas with a mouthfilling richness on the palate - seafood & salads.*

### Burgundy

- 9 *Macon - Chardonnay* *Talmard* 2012/14 2 **20.00**

*Very fresh, clean and well made. Light crisp fruit at the beginning with a background of fairly rich complexity on the finish. This is Macon is rich and has hints of light citrusy fruit and creamy texture. It is both made from Chardonnay and comes from the village of Chardonnay.*

- 11 *Chablis Premier Cru AOC* *Domaine Servin  
Vaillons* 2014 1 **38.00**

*This Chablis comes from an acclaimed family. A tip-top vintage from one of the appellation's finest Premier Cru vineyards. Crisp, citrusy, stony fresh and very elegant.*

### Loire

- 13 *Muscadet* *Sur Lie* *Fief de la Brie* 2013 1 **17.00**

*Full and fruity, yet bone dry, perfect for fish, shellfish and white meats.*

- 14 *Pouilly Fume* *Mathilde De Favray* 2013 1 **30.00**

*An exceptionally elegant white from France's Loire valley, this wine is bone dry and aromatic, with mouth-watering lemon and a fresh mineral hint.*

- 15 *Sancerre* *Domaine Daulny* 2014 1 **25.00**

*Superb wine to accompany fish—fresh, grassy, green Sauvignon with a delightful subtlety of flavour*

### Vin du Pays

- 16 *La Ciboise* *Chapoutier* 2009 3 **17.00**

*A blend of four different grapes - Grenache Blanc, Vermentino, Ugni Blanc and Roussanne - from Chapoutier who produces many of the finest wines from the Rhone valley.*

- 17 *Picpoul de Pinet* *Ressac* 2014 1 **18.00**

*A delightfully fresh, clean tasting and zesty white wine. Produced from Picpoul, one of the oldest grape varieties grown in the Languedoc. Perfect for lighter seafood dishes*

## England

- 19 *Bacchus Reserve* *Lamberhurst Estate* 2014 1 **24.00**

*Fresh, crisp and citrusy white made from the Bacchus grape, England's answer to Sauvignon Blanc - deserves investigation!*

## Japan

- 20 *Koshu* *Sol Lucet* 2013 2 **26.00**

*This is one of those great wines that come around very rarely from somewhere unusual. A light bodied white wine with pure and fresh flavours of Japanese citrus fruits such as kabosu and yuzu.*

## Austria

- 22 *Grüner Veltliner* *Rabl* 2014 1 **30.00**

*Grüner Veltliner, is "truly a great grape". This is one of the best from a very highly respected, Parker rated estate - a top vintage, it's crisp, mineral and complex.*

## Germany

- 25 *Rheinhessen Spatlese* Johannes Egberts 2012/13 5 **18.00**  
*Clean & well made wine - medium sweet with good balancing acid and fruit.*
- 26 *Riesling* Darting Estate 2014 2 **22.00**  
*A delightfully fresh and lively, dry German Riesling, vibrantly fruity with a crisp flavour of green apples and hints of orange and melon.*
- 27 *Reisling* Ernst Loosen 2014 2 **25.00**  
*Classic yet modern German Riesling, Schieferblume is a dazzling, citrus, apricot and apple scented delight*

## Croatia

- 28 *Golden Valley Grasevina* Golden Valley 2014 2 **20.00**  
*This sublime white from the wine-growing hills of Kutjevo, has luscious aromas of ripe peach and tropical fruits with zesty acidity. A heart-warming partner for roast chicken or pork with crackling or lovely with crab cakes and seafood dishes.*

## Spain

- 29 *Viña Esmeralda* Torres 2014/14 2 **20.00**  
*This Wine is an inspired blend of gewurztraminer and muscat grapes - A must for fans of aromatic wines, this is floral and fruity with orange blossom aromas and citrus flavours - Fantastic with gently spicy dishes.*
- 30 *Perla del Mar* Vino de Mesa 2014 1 **21.00**  
*Nothing compares to Perla del Mar - off dry, fruity, elegant and delightfully crisp. It's much down to the native Moscatel grape with a zip of Sauvignon freshness plus the winemaking skills of Scottish born Pamela Geddes.*

## Portugal

- 31 *Alvarinho* Tercius 2013 2 **24.00**  
*The high quality Alvarinho grape is becoming increasingly popular and this delicious white wine is a fine example of the variety.*

## Italy

- 32 *Soave* Cantina de Monteforte 2013 2 **16.00**  
*Light and dry and soft. Created from the Garganega grape. Light and easy to drink.*
- 33 *Pinot Grigio* Delle Venezie 2014 1 **20.00**  
*A fruity, ripe, top-quality example of the popular Italian white Pinot Grigio. This wine has wonderfully fresh, zesty flavours of lemon and lime and a tangy, with a clear dry finish.*

## Greece

- 34 *Atlantis Santorini* Atlantis Santorini 2014 1 **23.00**  
*Atlantis has all the bright citrus of an elegant Sauvignon but with a complex charm all its own. Hints of fresh fruits and a light mineral tang suggestive of its coastline location. The Assyrtiko vines for this wine are over 60 years old, giving their fruit fabulously rich flavour.*

## South Africa

- 36 *Chenin Blanc* The Huguenot 2014 1 **20.00**  
*This is a wonderfully fruity white using the Loire's Chenin Blanc - a grape that now excels in the Cape sunshine. Full of ripe fruit flavour and not a drop of oak, it's a refreshing guava and citrus crisp wine - great to tuck into any time*
- 37 *Sauvignon Blanc* Origin Wines 2013 2 **20.00**  
*Ripe concentrated gooseberry aromas with a mineral character on the palate*

## Australia

- 42 *Chardonnay* *Sisters Run* 2011/12 3 **20.00**  
*The intense bouquet is pleasantly fruity with highlights of green pear and peach with a pleasant palate of citrus and peach with fresh acidity.*
- 43 *Sauvignon Blanc* *The Regions* 2012 1 **22.00**  
*Displays fresh, crisp, acidity combined with citrus fruit and green apple.*

## New Zealand

- 47 *Sauvignon Blanc* *Cloudy Bay* 2013 1 **42.00**  
*Unique! Aromas of passionfruit & lemongrass. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry flavours and a hint of fresh fennel leading to a powerful, crisp finish.*
- 48 *Sauvignon Blanc - Black Label* *Babich* 2014 1 **24.00**  
*Crisp, fresh with ripe aromas of Gooseberry and citrus fruits. Exceptional value.*
- 50 *Reisling* *Babich* 2008/11 2 **23.00**  
*An intensely flavoured reisling displaying characteristic citrus & floral aromas balanced by ripe flavours and an off-dry finish.*

## Chile

- 55 *Chardonnay* *Cascara* 2013 3 **22.00**  
*This delightful, zesty Chardonnay is made in Limari which is now famous for more citrus dominant wines with beautiful acidity.*
- 56 *Sauvignon Blanc ~ Organic* *Gamma* 2014 2 **23.00**  
*This organic Sauvignon Blanc offers zingy lime zest and crunchy green pepper aromas over a mouthwatering palate positively alive with zippy fresh fruit and mineral complexities over a long, lingering finish.*
- 57 *Sauvignon Blanc - Single Vineyard* *Errazuriz* 2010/11 1 **30.00**  
*Delightful passion fruit and herbal notes combined with bright acidity and crisp mineral flavours lead to a pleasant, long finish.*

## Brazil

- 58 *Pinot Grigio* *Aracauria* 2014 2 **18.00**  
*This dry, fresh white is infused with crunchy apple and pear flavours overlaid with hints of zest and spice. These high altitude vineyards produce wonderfully aromatic Riesling fruit that Jeneve has blended with fresh, elegant Pinot Grigio.*

## United States of America

- 59 *Chardonnay* *Sand Point* 2010 3 **19.00**  
*Richly toasty Chardonnay full of mellow peach and melon flavours with a tang of orange-zest acidity keeping things lively. There are elegant, gently tropical aromas too, adding to the gorgeous freshness of this sprightly white. Satin-smooth wine, easy-going and easy to enjoy.*

# Red Wines

## France

### Bordeaux

- 61 *Cheateau Bel Air de L'Orme* Grands Vins De Gironde 2011 C **20.00**

*This Wine has a beautiful deep red color. The nose reveals red fruit aromas. On the palate, the frank attack opens up to round and persistent tannins. This wine is well structured and very pleasant.*

- 62 *Cave Bel Air* Yvan Meyer 2009 C **27.00**

*Maison Sichel make this classic Bordeaux blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon - Its bright, berry-scented aromas and ripe black fruit flavours make it a very happy match for all roasts.*

- 63 *Chateau Saint-Saturnin Cru* Adrien Traminer 2005 D **38.00**

*This Beautiful wine has on the nose Luscious black fruit aromas, chocolate, and a wild berry note too. Generous fruit palate, with a creamy dark fruits, revealing in its middle a slight trace of chocolate. The finish is accompanied by silky tannins & supported by floral notes.*

- 64 *Château Cissac* Vialard 2010,11,12 D **35.00**

*Cru Bourgeois Supérieur. A very traditional chateau producing wines of great character & complexity.*

- 65 *Chateau Haut Plaisance* Château Plaisance 2006 D **40.00**

*This particular blend is mostly Merlot, with Cabernets Sauvignon and Franc making up the balance. And it is indeed all about the balance with this wine; redcurrant fruit flavours sit happily with spice, oak and a hint of leather. Makes a perfect partner for stronger flavoured, hard cheeses & red Meats. A Superb Red Wine*

### Burgundy

- 69 *Côte de Beaune-Villages* Louis Jadot 2013 C **35.00**

*An elegant and sophisticated wine, combining a firm structure with a good weight of forest fruit flavours on the mid-palate, and a mellow texture leading to a fine and finish.*

- 70 *Nuit-St-George* Louis Max 2009 D **54.00**

*Robust and yet elegantly fruity, this wine offers charming red fruit aromas and a full, savoury palate.*

### Beaujolais

- 72 *Fleurie* Georges Duboeuf 2014 B **23.00**

*This wine is suited to you if you prefer lighter, soft fruity wines. This Fleurie has more going on than your average Beaujolais. Look out for the bright cerise colour, an enticing floral perfume and a ripe and soft strawberry and mulberry flavour.*

### Rhone

- 75 *Cotes Du Rhone* Cellier Des Dauphins 2012 C **26.00**

*Deliciously bold, big-hearted Rhône red, with everything the Grenache grape is famous for. Smoky flavours of cherry and plum; crisp, cranberry acidity, then blackberry and smooth blueberry fruit mellowing towards an oaky cedar finish. Wonderfully complex.*

- 76 *Châteauneuf du Pape* Saint Louis 2014 D **36.00**

*This Chateauneuf-du-Pape offers intense aromas of cocoa, plums and black cherries. Les Galets de Saint Louis is a powerful, rich and spicy aromatic wine.*

- 77 *Chateauneuf du Pape Les Haut des* Cellier des Princes 2010/13 E **55.00**

*A powerful wine, bursting with flavour. A perfect example of a great Châteauneuf du Pape*

## Germany

- 80 *Pinot Noir* Karl H Jobner 2008 B **36.00**  
*A voluptuous Pinot Noir from Baden, Germany's warmest wine-producing region. Jobner has created a soft-textured & perfumed red with dark berry fruits & spice notes. It drinks smoothly on its own or is delicious lamb, beef or pork.*

## Spain

- 81 *Rioja* Lagunilla 2009 D **25.00**  
*A deep cherry red colour, this wine has a bouquet of red berry fruit with persistent aromas of toasted wood and a well balanced palate with light acidity and rounded tannins. The finish is balanced and pleasing.*
- 83 *Finca Villacreces* Lalo Anton 2006 D **48.00**  
*Deep purple in colour with a complex nose of intense mocha, cranberry and cassis aromas. Plenty of ripe, dark berry fruit, a good balance and a very long finish. One of the Best Spanish wines we have ever had.*

## Portugal

- 86 *Cabeça de Toiro Reserva* António Leite 2008 D **21.00**  
*A standout example of just how vibrant and fruit-loaded the wines from Tejo can be. Rich and ripe with intense black fruits and a touch of spice and mocha, together with silky, supple tannins.*

## Italy

- 87 *Chianti ~ D.O.C.G.* Poggio Teo 2009 C **30.00**  
*A sublime example of Italian Fine Wines. Med bodied with soft acidity, nice food friendly wine.*
- 88 *Valpolicella Classico ~ DOC* Giuseppe Lonardi 2009/13 B **20.00**  
*Dry, medium bodied, with a characteristic slight bitterness which is very appealing*
- 89 *Valpolicella Ripasso* Rocca Alata 2012/13 D **26.00**  
*This is a delicious wine of great elegance and appeal, with a rich bouquet of wild red berry, and smooth nuances of liquorice and mint*
- 90 *Valpolicella Ripasso ~ Special* Cantina Della Valpantena 2013 D **30.00**  
*A ripe and concentrated yet wonderfully smooth red wine, bursting with juicy flavours and aromas of redcurrants, strawberries and prunes, with hints of plain chocolate and roasted nuts.*
- 91 *Amarone Della Valpolicella* Rocca Alata 2012 D **36.00**  
*Complex and richly textured with spice, Morello cherries, coffee and even a hint of chocolate, there's so much going on in the glass; this is a real statement wine. It absolutely demands food to really bring out the flavours and soften those tannins - Roasted red meats are best, especially lamb, beef or game - It works brilliantly with strong, hard cheeses too.*

## Greece

- 92 *Red on Black* Kostas Mitravelas 2014 D **18.00**  
*This is a vibrant Greek red with cherry, plum and redcurrant fruit, great depth of flavours and soft, rounded tannins.*

## Romania

- 93 *Shiraz* Burebista 2014 D **22.00**  
*From a highly reputed cellar, this red presents Shiraz's usual spicy exuberance with the velvet black fruit of a true Romanian original.*

## **Lebanon**

- 94 *Chateau Musar* Gaston Hochar 2004 E **41.00**  
*"A red wine which ranks among the best and certainly most interesting in the world"*

## **Israel**

- 97 *Shiraz ~ Petit Sirab* Recanati 2014 C **20.00**  
*This warm, medium bodied red wine combines flavours of fresh cassis with blueberry fruit while the gentle aging in French oak barrels introduces subtle spice notes.*

## **South Africa**

- 98 *Pinotage* Man Vintners 2013 C **19.00**  
*A modern style that showcases the best Pinot Noir-like characteristics of Pinotage. Juicy bright fruits, soft tannins and a perfumed nose make this a very accessible Pinotage. Excellent with hearty red meat dishes.*

- 99 *Merlot ~ Cabernet Sauvignon* Journey's End Kendal 2013 D **23.00**  
*This succulent and supple red wine has spicy red berry aromas and delightfully rich flavours of blackcurrant, cherry and plum, with hints of clove and mint on the finish.*

- 100 *Shiraz* Home of Origin wine 2012 D **21.00**  
*An abundance of fruit on the nose from blackcurrant, dark cherries to hints of plum. The fruit aromas compliments the palette and adds a bit of finesse to the wine. A great balance and a lingering aftertaste.*

## **Australia**

- 101 *Weighbridge Shiraz* Peter Lehmann 2012 C **18.00**  
*A medium body wineshowing good rounded berry fruit with a soft, long finish.*

- 102 *Cabernet ~ Merlot* Tempus Two 2011/12 D **18.00**  
*Well-balanced and full-bodied, exhibiting rich berry fruit and chocolate flavours. Matured in both French and American barriques for ten months to capture and enhance the complexities*

- 110 *Pinot Noir* Burfield 2014 B **21.00**  
*A great summer red from South Eastern Australia, this is packed with juicy raspberry and redcurrant fruit flavours so typical of good New World Pinot Noir - One to match with pulled pork.*

- 111 *Black Duck Durif* Trimboli 2014 D **22.00**  
*A bold big red with dinner 'wow' factor. One of the best Durif's you will ever taste. Full of ripe black fruits & hints of pepper.*

- 112 *Shiraz* DGS 2010 D **30.00**  
*Intense filled with black cherry, plum and mulberry aromas with an intriguing twist of Chinese Five Spice and charred oak.*

## **New Zealand**

- 115 *Merlot Cabernet Malbec* CJ Pask 2009/10 C **23.00**  
*Blackberry notes from the Cabernet mingle with the softer plum aromas of the Merlot.*

- 117 *Pinot Noir* Cloudy Bay 2011 B **49.00**  
*A garnet coloured wine with soft, earthy aromas of cherry, plum & spice. A soft, supple wine of medium length and intensity. with a delicious plummy fruit character layered over charry oak.*

- 118 *Pinot Noir* Babich 2010,11,13 C **22.00**  
*A light, fragrant ruby wine. Perfect with pretty well anything!*

## Chile

- 120 *Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva* Coquimbo 2010 D **26.00**  
*The nose is packed with layers of caramel, cinnamon, candy and hints of mint, with a prevalence of fruit over oak. A spicy, full-flavored wine, with good body, rich red fruit with a touch of vanilla and firm and friendly tannins.*
- 121 *Carmenere - Reerva* Cono Sur 2012 C **23.00**  
*Carménère has a deep red color and aromas found in red fruits, spices and berries. The tannins are gentler and softer than those in Cabernet Sauvignon and it is a medium body wine*
- 122 *Merlot* Don Cayetano 2014 C **22.00**  
*A rich, smooth, full bodied red from Chile, packed with ripe, juicy blueberry and plum fruit, with a hint of licorice and mocha on the nose and palate*
- 123 *Merlot ~ Single Vineyard* Don Manuel 2013 C **26.00**  
*Masterful Merlot, barrel aged to perfection. This wine is Chile at its best, with silken, pure fruit flavours, sumptuous depth and a reassuringly long finish.*

## Argentina

- 124 *Malbec* Finca Agostino 2013 D **24.00**  
*A fine example of a Argentinian Malbec with Plum and raspberry flavours combining elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak.*
- 125 *Malbec Golden Reserve* Trivento 2013 D **32.00**  
*A wine of great personality, it offers red fruit aromas of plum and cherry and hints of chocolate and vanilla. Fruity and rounded on the palate, it has sweet tannins to produce a persistent and pleasing finish.*

## Brazil

- 127 *Intenso Teroldego* Vinicola Salton 2013 C **20.00**  
*This is a fascinating wine from Teroldego grapes. Teroldego originates in northern Italy, and the wines of Campanha Gaucha still very much reflect their Italian heritage. Supple medium-bodied red wine with intense blackberry aromas and an easy unoaked elegance. Vivid notes of dark cherry, pomegranate, flowers and herbs fill the palate.*

## Uruguay

- 128 *Pisano Cisplatino Tannat* Progreso 2014 D **18.00**  
*This bold Uruguayan red offers smoky plum, herb and spice aromas over a juicy, gently oaked blackberry and raspberry palate.*

## Canada

- 129 *Pinot Noir* Meyer 2014 C **35.00**  
*This Pinot Noir is one of the best available. It is a complex Pinot Noir with tart black cherry, plum and vanilla aromas and a richly elegant freshness with violets and red fruit depth.*

## United States of America

- 133 *Zinfandel* Ravens Wood 2012 E **22.00**  
*A very powerful, full bodied wine.*
