## France

### Bordeaux

6 *Château Le Bonalguet - Sauvignon* Bordeaux Alexandre Sueur 2020 30

*This is a fine, oak fermented, creamy textured Sauvignon handcrafted in tiny quantities. It combines the bright freshness of a modern Bordeaux white with a rich cream layer thanks to meticulous winemaking.*

### Burgundy

9 *Mâcon Villages* Mâconnais Louis Jadot 2020 33

*One of the Very Best Macon Villages. An elegant unoaked Chardonnay with citrus flower and tropical fruit aromas over a creamy, rounded palate that offers some intriguing mineral notes on the finish.*

11 *Chablis* Chablis Domaine Dampt 2019/20 45

*Domaine Dampt is a star among the great names of Chablis. From a high quality, low yield vintage, this Vieilles Vignes has brilliant citrus, mineral intensity*

12 *Chablis 1er Cru* Chablis DOMAINE SERVIN 2019 69

*Bright white fruits, blossom, oyster shell and citrus with a fine mineral streak at its core, this 1er Cru from a 5-star vintage will reward patience.*

### Loire

13 *Muscadet Sur Lie* Sèvre-et-Maine Domaine de la Tourmaline 2020/21 27

*Full and fruity, yet bone dry, perfect for fish, shellfish and white meats.*

14 *Pouilly Fume* Saint Andelain Domaine de Bel Air 2020 39

*Pure, classic Pouilly-Fumé. Concentrated and mouthwatering but full of bright citrus. Tight and fine*

15 *Sancerre* Loire Domaine Michel Thomas 21~23 41

*Superb wine to accompany fish—fresh, grassy, green Sauvignon with a delightful subtlety of flavour*

### Vin du Pays

17 *Picpoul de Pinet* Coteaux De Languedoc Villemarin 2021 27

*Intense aromas of white summer fruit with an essence of orange blossom. Produced from Picpoul, one of the oldest grape varieties grown in the Languedoc. Perfect for lighter seafood dishes*

## England

19 *Bacchus Reserve* Kent Chappel Down 2018/21 34

*Fresh, crisp and citrusy white made from the Bacchus grape, England's answer to Sauvignon Blanc - deserves investigation!*

## Moldova

20 *Viorica* Jora de Mijloc Chateau Vartely 2020 27

*This is an exciting new-release from Moldova - Viorica is an exciting grape discovered in 1969. It makes fresh, herbal and tropical scented whites, serve on its own or with lighter dishes - noodles, pan fried chicken or prawns.*

## Austria

22 *Grüner Veltliner* Kremstal Danaris 2020 29

*Grüner Veltliner, is "truly a great grape". This is one of the best from a very highly respected, Parker rated estate - a top vintage, it's crisp, mineral and complex.*

## Romania

23 Pinot Grigio Transylvania BABELE 2021 27

*Enjoy a classic Pinot Grigio, from hand harvested grapes grown on high, terraced vineyards in Romania's Transylvania. Very versatile, this is a great anytime wine.*

## Germany

26 Riesling Mosel Dr Loosen 2020/21 28

*A superb modern premium Riesling from Germany. It has a clean refreshing bouquet with citrus and peach notes and a hint of spice. The palate is rich with a balance of fruit and acidity with mineral finish.*

## Georgia

27 Qvevris Georgia Tbilvino 2019 29

*This wine from Tbilvino is a very Georgian affair. Rkatsiteli is one of the oldest grapes in the world, traditional to Georgia. In this amber wine, you'll find notes of apricot and pear. Wonderful with barbequed lamb.*

## Hungary

28 Campanula Pinot Grigio Etyek Campanula 2019/21 27

*This terrific Pinot Grigio comes from an award winning cellar in the village of Etyek. This crisp, mineral Pinot Grigio has classic ripe pear and green apple character. Enjoy as a glass any time.*

## Spain

29 Albarino Rias Baixas Martín Códax 2020/21 32

*A dazzling fresh Albariño - hero white grape of North West Spain. its brilliant lime zip to perfection in the Atlantic cooled vineyards of Valle de Saines. Revel in the freshness of this aromatic, citrus white.*

## Croatia

30 Graševina ~ "Quality Dry Wine" Kutjevo Slavonia 2018/21 30

*Meet Graševina - the queen of white grapes in Croatia. It has fresh apple and peach fruit, underlined by a saline, citrus minerality, not unlike the style of good Picpoul.*

## Portugal

31 Alvarinho Vinho Verde Casal de Ventozela 2019/20 27

*Casal De Ventozela produces one of our most popular Vinho Verdes out of the native Arinto grape variety. Its Alvarinho is extremely fresh with flavours of citrus and apple.*

## Italy

32 Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie SENTIERO DEI PINI 2023 27

*A premium Pinot Grigio displaying fine concentration of flavour and a highly refreshing character. Look out for the succulent, zesty lime juice flavour, and a whistle-clean, almost mineral note on the finish.*

33 White Sangiovese Tuscany Sofia 2021 27

*A dazzlingly fresh white, Picked early, this red grape makes a crisp white with notes of sour cherry. Deliciously different and spot on with risotto.*

## Greece

34 Assyrtiko Crete Lyrarakis 2019/20 28

*Dive into Greek wine with this bone dry, extremely fresh white. It's fragrant with wild aromas of meadow flower and yellow orchard fruit backed by a heavy dose of chalk minerality and green apple.*

## South Africa

36 *Chenin Blanc* Western Cape The Huguenot 2021 26

*This is a wonderfully fruity white using Loire's Chenin Blanc - a grape that now excels in the Cape sunshine. Full of ripe fruit flavour and not a drop of oak, it's a refreshing guava and citrus crisp wine - great to tuck into any time*

37 *Sauvignon Blanc* Western Cape Gooseberry Bush 2021 30

*It's easy to see why, every year, South Africa's Gooseberry Bush outsells any of our NZ Sauvignons by a long chalk. It's that leap-from-the-glass, grassy freshness.*

## Australia

42 *Chardonnay ~ Reserve* SE Australia Burra Brook 2020 27

*A Namesake of Shetland's Burra, Vanilla and stone Fruit flavours & graceful in feel.*

43 *Sauvignon Blanc* SE Australia McPherson Family 2021 27

*This Sauvignon, made by the acclaimed McPherson family cellar, offers tongue tingling, ripe, citrus flavours, with juicy, tropical notes. A very gulpable white.*

## New Zealand

47 *Sauvignon Blanc* Marlborough Cloudy Bay 21~24 58

*Unique! Aromas of passionfruit & lemongrass. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry flavours and a hint of fresh fennel leading to a powerful, crisp finish.*

48 *Sauvignon Blanc ~ Organic* Marlborough Babich 2021 33

*Crisp, fresh with ripe aromas of Gooseberry and citrus fruits. Exceptional value.*

50 *Pinot Grigio* Nelson Waimea Estate 2021 29

*A nose of pear drop, blossom and nectarine leading to a palate that is softer, richer and more tropical in flavour than its European counterpart. Lovely purity of fruit with a smooth finish.*

## Chile

55 *Chardonnay ~ Gran Reserva* Casablanca Luis Felipe Edwards 2021 28

*This wine is unbelievably well balanced, with subtle tropical stone fruit in the form of apricot and peach mingling with subtle oak characters and a rich creaminess.*

56 *Sauvignon Blanc ~ Gran Reserva* Layda Valley Luis Felipe Edwards 19~22 28

*Combining cool climate freshness with amazing ripeness courtesy of Elqui Valley's extraordinary vineyards, this is Sauvignon as you've never tasted it before.*

## Slovenia

57 *Sauvignon Blanc* Slovenia Krasno 2020 28

*This is made just over the border from Friuli, in Italy, where similar wines demand considerably higher prices. It's fresh and elegant, with plenty of green-apple flavours, floral aromas and a fruity finish.*

## United States of America

58 *Chardonnay* California Edna Valley 2018 33

*White peach. Apricot. Melon. The flavours are seriously ripe, but it's still deliciously crisp and refreshing. A touch of oak rounds out the edges and gives it a subtle spiciness. Perfect to dress up simple pumpkin ravioli.*

## Argentina

59 *Chardonnay* Mendoza Viñalta 2019 27

*Delightful passion fruit and herbal notes combined with bright acidity and crisp mineral flavours lead to a long finish.*

60 *White Malbec* Mendoza Alambrado 2021 29

*Malbec, the ultimate red wine grape. Or so you may have thought. It can also make exceptional and different white wines. By taking away the skins and using only the juice, the winemaker has created a distinctively fruity, deliciously fresh white.*

# Red Wines

## France

### Bordeaux

60 *Château Recougne ~ Supérieur* Haut *Château Recougne* 2018 27  
*A Delicious Red packed with delectable bramble notes, regal spices and integrated tannins.*

61 *Malbec* Pays d'Oc IGP *D'HERVÉ* 2022 29  
*A gorgeous, fruit filled Malbec to rival those of Argentina. The perfect balance of red summer fruit aromas, vibrant raspberry, plum and ripe cherry flavours and velvety tannins. It's a silky, expressive wine and the perfect choice for enjoying with pork.*

62 *Chateau Livran* Medoc *Chateau Livran* 2014 31  
*Rich, ripe, finely crafted Médoc. Mostly Merlot with a little Cabernet from a superbly positioned vineyard, this Bordeaux boasts fine tannins that balance flavours of blackcurrant, mulberry and regal spices.*

63 *Rex Mundi* Pays d'Oc IGP *Bernard Magrez* 2019 25  
*Don't even try to resist, just sip and enjoy this lusciously ripe, juicy marriage of liquorice scented Shiraz and lush, silken Grenache. Gloriously easy to quaff on its own, it also goes well with barbecued meats, Cajun chicken or lamb chops.*

64 *Château Cissac* Haut Medoc *La Batisse* 2018 44  
*This wine has the classic hallmarks of Great Haut-Médoc claret - cedar wood, cassis and liquorice complexity - it's ripe, rounded and harmonious. Superb with rare beef.*

65 *Château Moine Vieux Grand Cru* St Emilion *Moine Vieux* 2016 56  
*This is a supple, silky, appealing Grand Cru. 2016 had a hard act to follow after the blazing 2015, but has been described as "outstanding"(JS). Lovely fruit and length. Toasty, smoky blackcurrant and earthy blackberry aromas, lush dark berry fruit, laced with plum, liquorice, cherry and spice with a deliciously long finish.*

### Burgundy

69 *Côte de Beaune-Villages* Côtes de *Bouchard Aîné* 2017- 54  
*An elegant and sophisticated wine, combining a firm structure with a good weight of forest fruit flavours on the mid-palate, and a mellow texture leading to a fine and finish.*

70 *Nuit-St-George* Côte d'Or *Jean Chauvenet* 2019 82  
*A top example of red Burgundy from the Côte d'Or, this wine has excellent ripe, soft fruit, with redcurrant and cassis flavours, fine tannins, and hints of spicy clove and hazelnut.*

### Beaujolais

72 *Fleurie* Fleurie *Georges Duboeuf* 2020 33  
*This wine is suited to you if you prefer lighter, soft fruity wines. This Fleurie has more going on than your average Beaujolais. Look out for the bright cerise colour, an enticing floral perfume and a ripe and soft strawberry and mulberry flavour.*

### Rhone

75 *Cotes Du Rhone* Côtes du *Le Prince de* 2020 28  
*As close as you could hope to come to an authentic Châteauneuf style without paying the premium. Finest Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre from neighbouring vineyards combine beautifully to give herb scented, velvety black fruit, liquorice and spice.*

76 *Chateauneuf-du-Pape* Chateauneuf- *Hommage à J* 2019- 52  
*This Chateauneuf-du-Pape offers intense aromas of cocoa, plums and black cherries. This is a powerful, rich and spicy aromatic wine.*

77 *Chateauneuf du Pape* Chateauneuf- *Le Prince de* 2019 63  
*A powerful wine, bursting with flavour. A perfect example of a great Châteauneuf du Pape*

## Spain

81 Rioja - Gran Reserva Rioja Viña Alarde 2013 29

*A deep cherry red colour, this wine has a bouquet of red berry fruit with persistent aromas of toasted wood and a well balanced palate with light acidity and rounded tannins. The finish is balanced and pleasing.*

83 Muga Rioja Reserva Rioja Hidden 2018 41

*This is the flagship single vineyard Reserva from a great Rioja family, made in a 5-Star vintage.*

## Portugal

85 Lobo e Falcão Tejo Lobo de Vasconcellos 2021 30

*Fans of smooth, mouthfilling wines take note - this is a sure contender for the Big Red crown. A delicious blend of Portuguese grapes from Lobo e Falcão has lovely warmth, satisfying richness and dark, spicy fruit*

## Germany

86 Pinot Noir Pfalz Von Reben 2020 28

*Enjoy all the ripe berry fruit and silky charms of Pinot Noir in this pretty, silky red. Germany's Pfalz region excels with this grape and produces better value wines than Burgundy. From a quality conscious cellar, a red with elegant fruit appeal.*

## hungary

87 Kékfrankos Nagy Eged Stumpf 2018 35

*From Nagy Eged - the finest vine-growing area of this region. Kékfrankos thrives on the mountain's ancient volcanic soils. Much like Old World Pinot Noir, this has bright flavours of red fruit and a delicious savoury character. Silky smooth tannins make this an excellent pairing for pasta pomodoro with fresh basil.*

## Italy

88 Chianti DOCG Riserva Tuscany Fantini Terre Natuzzi 2017 32

*Chianti is a timeless Italian classic, while Riserva signifies a superior wine with ageing. This Tuscan wine is excellent and good value.*

89 Primitivo Puglia Pillastro 2018 28

*Rippling with spiced bramble fruit flavours. Rich, smooth and incredibly easy to drink. All powered by the ripest, old-vine Primitivo grapes from twice-named 'Winery of the Year'.*

90 Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso Veneto La Casetta 2017-2018 37

*A beautiful deep ruby hue and lots of almost confected cherry, plum and berry fruits complemented by vanilla hints. Fine and rounded, a velvety smooth palate bursting with intense and complex flavours.*

91 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Veneto Cantina Negrar 2018 54

*Complex and richly textured with spice, Morello cherries, coffee and even a hint of chocolate, there's so much going on in the glass; this is a real statement wine. It absolutely demands food to really bring out the flavours and soften those tannins - Roasted red meats are best, especially lamb, beef or game - It works brilliantly with strong, hard cheeses too.*

## Austria

92 Danaris ~ Blauer Zweigelt Niederösterreich Calos HJ Fabre 2017-2020 32

*Never heard of Blauer Zweigelt? It's an Austrian variety that's definitely worth knowing, producing cherry fruited wines with an attractive pepper tingle. From the heart of premium Kremstal, this is a delicate, ripe and silky red.*

## Greece

93 Xinomavro Nemea Thymiopoulos 2018 31

*This is one of Greece's star grapes. Think of it as a delicious cross between Barbaresco and Pinot Noir. It's medium-bodied and complex, with notes of red and black fruit, a vibrant acidity and a long finish.*

## Lebanon

94 Chateau Musar Bekaa Gaston Hochar 94

*"A red wine which ranks among the best and certainly most interesting in the world"*

## Romania

95 *Feteasca Neagra* Huși Nativus 2019 34

*From a highly reputed cellar, this red presents Shiraz's usual spicy exuberance with the velvet black fruit of a true Romanian original grape Feteasca Neagra.*

## England

96 *The Bolney Estate Pinot Noir* West Sussex Bolney 2019 51

*Cool-climate Pinot Noir. It's vibrant and bright, with flavours of ripe strawberries, plums, red cherry, toasted almonds and leather. Great with asparagus, pork and game birds.*

## Moldova

97 *Cabernet Sauvignon* Valul lui Traian Château Vartely 2017-2018 28

*From a French styled château in Moldova that was founded as recently as 2008, this rich, oak aged Cabernet has quality to rival acclaimed wines from Bordeaux or California at three times the price. Dense, textured, ripe cassis with a touch of oak.*

## South Africa

98 *Pinotage* Western Cape Barista 2018-2020 27

*This is a deliberately modern offering concentrates on drawing out the coffee-like aromas of South Africa's signature grape. Intense on the nose, with a bouquet of coffee, chocolate and cherry, with meaty, savoury hints.*

99 *Merlot~Cab Sauv~Cab Franc* Stellenbosh Journey's End Kendal 2019 28

*This succulent and supple red wine has spicy red berry aromas and delightfully rich flavours of blackcurrant, cherry and plum, with hints of clove and mint on the finish.*

100 *Rustenberg* Stellenbosh RM Nicholson 2020 29

*Blackcurrant aromas are complemented by notes of dried herbs and black pepper. The palate is fleshy and firmly structured, with weighty red fruit flavours and bold tannins*

## Australia

101 *Shiraz* SE Australia McPherson Family 2021 29

*The perfect red for a long, lazy Sunday lunch. That's what Andrew McPherson had in mind when he set aside his estate's darkest, richest Shiraz to create this signature release.*

102 *Merlot* Victoria Firespinner 2019-2021 31

*Lush, gorgeously fruity and eminently drinkable Merlot from the warm vineyards of Central Victoria. Subtly integrated French oak flatters the juicy ripe plum, fruit cake and exotic spice of this attractive red*

110 *Purple Duck Pinot Noir* New South Wales Trimboli 2021 29

*A great summer red from South Eastern Australia, this is packed with juicy raspberry and redcurrant fruit flavours so typical of good New World Pinot Noir - One to match with pulled pork.*

111 *Black Duck Durif* Riverina Trimboli 2021 33

*A bold big red with dinner 'wow' factor. One of the best Durif's you will ever taste. Full of ripe black fruits & hints of pepper.*

## Peru

112 *Tannat* Tacama Don Manuel 2018 55

*Deep, dark and velvety Tannat. This is a serious red, voluptuous, ripe black fruit with Bordeaux-like structure. A cracking intro to Peru's class reds.*

## Uruguay

114 *Ombu Reserve Petit Verdot* Pisano Cislatino Braccobosca 2020 33

*This bold Uruguayan red offers smoky plum, herb and spice aromas over a juicy, gently oaked blackberry and raspberry palate.*

## New Zealand

115 Syrah Hawke's Bay Te Mata Estate 2019 41

*This delicious wine. Strong with a long and powerful finish, it's full of red-fruit, vanilla and allspice flavours. Sublime with grilled beef.*

117 Pinot Noir Marlborough Cloudy Bay 2015-22 78

*A garnet coloured wine with soft, earthy aromas of cherry, plum & spice. A soft, supple wine of medium length and intensity. with a delicious plummy fruit character layered over charray oak.*

118 Pinot Noir Reserve Marlborough Rapaura 2019 37

*For this Pinot Noir, the grapes were selected from premium sites throughout Marlborough to gain a balance of fruit, freshness and structure. Made just like a top Burgundy, in open top fermenters, with plunge down several times a day, plus gentle oak, the wine has depth and richness.*

## Chile

120 Cabernet Sauvignon ~ Gran Reserva Maipo Valley Santa Rita 2018-2019 28

*Gentle, well-rounded wine with aromas of red fruit and complex notes of blackcurrant, vanilla, chocolate on the palate. Fabulously smooth, and rich with warm hazelnut tones on the finish, this is a multi-layered treasure of a wine: robust, but utterly mouthwatering.*

121 Carmenere - Gran Reserva Elqui Valley Mayu 2018-2019 27

*If you like Amarone, you'll be impressed with this interesting bottle - full of smoky balsamic red fruit that's given a sweetly spicy edge from the US oak. perfect match for beef daube or barbecued steak.*

122 Merlot ~ Estate Series Valle de Curicó Errázuriz 2018-2019 27

*This is a soft, smooth Merlot guaranteed to wow the crowd. It has flavours of red fruit, caramel and mocha. Exceptional with rich tomato pasta.*

123 Merlot ~ Gran Reserva Colchagua Luis Felipe Edwards 2019-2020 31

*Masterful Merlot, barrel aged to perfection. This wine is Chile at its best, with silken, pure fruit flavours, sumptuous depth and a reassuringly long finish.*

## Argentina

124 Malbec ~Reserve Mendoza Opi/Viñalba 2019-2020 32

*This gorgeous red blazed a name for itself on the world stage when its debut vintage was named - 'Best Malbec of Argentina'. And that's some feat in a country that's world renowned for the quality of its Malbec. Velvet smooth with ripe black fruit.*

125 Malbec ~ Barrel Selection Patagonia HJ Fabre 2019/2020 42

*This Gold medal, 95-point red comes from 30 year old Malbec vines grown in Patagonia's Río Negro. Made like a fine claret and aged for a year in French oak barriques, it's powerful, yet elegant with silky violet and spicy plum fruit. Perfect with beef.*

127 Tannat Cafayate Amauta Absoluto 2018 28

*Grown on vines at an altitude of 1750mts, these are amongst the highest vineyards in the world. The Tannat has an intense colour with red fruits spice and menthol notes. The flavour is juicy, with well integrated tannins and balancing acidity on a long finish.*

## Bulgaria

129 Coline d'Enira Thracian Bessa Valley 2015-2016 27

*Bulgarian reds were top of the pops in the 1970s. Quality was good and the value unmatched. Now, thanks to privatisation of the vineyards and massive European investment, the quality is nothing short of astounding. treat this wine like a cru classé claret, filled with Merlot and Petit Verdot they are joined by Syrah for a delicious point of difference.*

## United States of America

133 Zinfandel California Ravens Wood 2018 32

*Surviving prohibition by a legal loophole, Lodi boasts some of America's most ancient Zinfandel vines. Old vines craft the juiciest grapes. So it's no surprise that this pumps with black-fruit flavour. If you like a full-bodied red with gallons of taste, you'll love this.*
